

# AGREEMENT OF EACH ENTRANT

In consideration of the acceptance of my / our entry(ies) and of the holding of the test and of the opportunity to have the dog tested and to win ribbons or trophies, I / we acknowledge and agree as follows:

- 1) The Ontario All Pointing Breed Field Dog Club (the O.A.P.B.F.D.C.) may refuse the entry for any cause, which the O.A.P.B. F.D.C. deems to be sufficient.
- 2) Field tests have certain inherent dangers associated with them including, without limitation, those due to the presence and / or use of firearms, and as such any person participating in the test or being present on the test grounds assumes the associated risks;
- 3) To hold the Canadian Kennel Club (the C.K.C.), any C.K.C. approved judge, the O.A.P.B.F.D.C., Its members, directors, officers, agents, committee members, test secretary, official gunners at the test and the owners or lessor of the test grounds and any employees of any of them (collectively, the 'Club'), harmless from:
  - a) Any claim for loss or injury which may be caused or alleged to be caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by any act of any dog I have entered in the test, or am responsible for, while in or upon the test; grounds or near any entrance to the test grounds;
  - b) Any claim for loss of any dog I have entered in the test, or am responsible for, by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether the loss, disappearance, theft, damage or Injury is caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club or any other person or any other cause or causes;
  - c) For bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting from bodily injuries, sustained by any person or persons, including myself / ourselves, any minors for whom I / We is or are responsible or on account of damage to property arising out of or in consequence of my / our or their participation in the test or presence on the test grounds, however such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not caused or alleged to be caused by negligence of the Club or any of them or any other person; and;

I / we personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I / we further agree to assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the Club harmless from any and all losses and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law or a court of competent jurisdiction upon the Club or any of them for any of the foregoing.

I / we agree bound by this Agreement of Each Entrant printed in the Official Premium List. I / we certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs.

## Driving Instructions to Pointblank Kennels

### From Toronto Area:

Take 401 East to 35/115 North

Take 115 to Peterborough

### From Peterborough:

Drive approximately 30 km East on Highway 7

Turn Left (North) on the 7th Line of Asphodel Township

Pointblank Kennels is the first driveway on the RIGHT after crossing the train tracks

### From Cobourg Area:

From the 401 take 45 North to Norwood (Highway 7)

Turn Left (West) on Highway 7

Turn Right (North) on 7th line of Asphodel Township

Pointblank Kennels is the first driveway on the RIGHT after crossing the train tracks

### Non-Member Participation Fee:

An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC.

In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled.

### NOTE Regarding the Running Of O.A.P.B. FD Tests At Pointblank Kennels

There will be **TWO** FDJ tests run on May 5, 2012.

There will be **TWO** FD, FDX tests run on May 6, 2012.

The course will be as different as practical for each test.

Your entry form must clearly indicate which test (or both) you are entering.

### Other Things You Should Know

- These tests are held under the **rules of the Canadian Kennel Club**, all Participants are expected to familiarize themselves with the rules. Rule books are available from the CKC or the OAPB Field Dog Club for a nominal fee.
- Entries are limited to the number of dogs that can be run during available daylight hours & will close if limits are reached prior to 8:00 p.m. May 1, 2012.
- **Any entry may be cancelled without penalty before the closing.**
- **Entries scratched after the closing must still pay their full entry fee & listing fee if applicable.** Failure to do so within 7 days of the test will be considered non-payment of fees.
- **Withdrawals of entries before or after the drawing must be made with the Field Test Secretary only.**
- **The drawing will be done at random. We will not pre-assign any participant a special place in the running order.**
- You are welcome to call about your dog's position in the running order; however we cannot guarantee the time of day any entry will run. It is the handler's duty to have his / her dog ready in place when required for judging.
- There will be **N O** training of dogs anywhere on the grounds during the tests.
- Qualifying entries will be announced at completion of the test.
- Bitches in season are permitted on the grounds & run at the end of the day.
- It is recommended that dogs competing have current immunization status.
- **Safety requires that FD / FDX handlers wear an article of blaze orange clothing.**
- If time permits, O.A.P.B. will confirm the receipt / rejection of each entry.

### SPECIAL NOTES

**Your entry into any O.A.P.B.F.D.C. sponsored event signifies your acceptance of the terms and conditions outlined in the "Agreement Of Each Entrant" (see final page for details).**

Any person participating in any capacity at a field test held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the test. It is the duty and obligation of the O.A.P.B.F.D.C. to see that this rule is effectively carried out. When a report of an alleged indignity (of any kind), is given to the O.A.P.B.F.D.C., the test committee of the O.A.P.B.F.D.C. shall forthwith conduct an investigation and shall render it's decision to the parties concerned. It shall also, within ten days after the test, report to the CKC the nature of the alleged indignity, the names of the parties concerned and it's findings. The Discipline Committee of the CKC shall have the power to take such actions as it deems fit.
